S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Charity Golf Tournament

VANCOUVER, September 4, 2007 – Organized by S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Foundation, the 3rd Annual S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Charity Golf Tournament, held at Mayfair Lakes Golf & Country Club in Richmond, has successfully raised over \$110,000 to benefit S.U.C.C.E.S.S. programs and services for seniors, youths, women and families in need, language training, health and wellness education and counseling.

Over 130 community-minded golfers and guests, in 25 teams, signed up to support S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Foundation. The event started with an Open Golf Clinic directed by CPGA professionals to ensure that players were ready to compete in the tournament and various contests. After enjoying a light lunch, the Tee-Off Ceremony were hosted by Mr. Lawrence Woo, Chair of S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Foundation, Mrs. Linda Wong and Mr. Danny Gaw, Co-Chairs of the tournament, followed by 1:00 pm Shotgun Start.

The importance of community programs to improve the lives of those who are in need was highlighted by Mr. Woo. Mrs. Wong and Mr. Gaw appreciated the tournament sponsors – including Chan Foundation of Canada, 1111 Melville Limited Partnership, Concord Pacific Group, and TELUS – for their generous support.

The tournament featured the Texas Scramble format to encourage teamwork and enjoyment among the participants. The golfers were given a series of opportunities to ace four par-3 holes to win prizes, including a Cadillac CTS and a Buick Enclave. Vehicles were generously provided by General Motors of Canada. Players can also try to eagle two holes for \$5,000 cash prizes. Throughout the course many holes featured games, refreshments and prizes.

The tournament was followed by an awards ceremony accompanied by a sumptuous dinner. Participants were given the opportunity to bid on A Six Months EasyPark VIP Parking Pass, Vancouver Canucks team autographed hockey sticks and many golf items.

The S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Cup was presented to the winning team. Other trophies were also presented to the longest male and female drivers, the straightest driver, closest to the pin winner and best putter.
