**Anthony Lun Charity Concert 2009  
with Special Guest Bianca Wu**

Vancouver – **Anthony Lun**, recognized as one of Asia’s premier singer, songwriter, arranger and musical director, will perform in a one night only benefit concert for S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Foundation on Friday, July 31 at The Centre in Vancouver for Performing Arts.

Lawrence Woo, Chairman of Anthony Lun Charity Concert 2009, proclaimed the event is targeted to raise \$50,000 to benefit S.U.C.C.E.S.S. programs and services for seniors in the communities.

In a pre-recorded interview, Mr. Lun expressed his support to S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Foundation and look forward to performing in Vancouver again.

Started his musical career in 1986, Anthony Lun immediately won the prestigious Asia Pacific Popular Song Contest the same year. Between 1987 and 1997, he composed over 300 songs with 42 No. 1 hits and sings in Cantonese, Mandarin, Japanese and English. Anthony has composed songs for numerous famous Asian artistes, most notably Sandy Lam and the late Anita Mui. For many years Anthony has been involved in fundraising activities for communities world-wide. Anthony Lun Charity Concert 2009 will be his first occasion to fundraise for S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Foundation.

Performing as a special guest with Mr. Lun on July 31 is **Bianca Wu**. Bianca is known for her unique style of fusing Jazz and R&B with Canton Pop music. This will be Bianca’s first appearance in Vancouver.

At today’s press conference, Betty Funston, Chair of S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Foundation, thanked Anthony Lun for traveling all the way from Hong Kong to headline the Charity Concert.
